The Sahlgrenska Academy

- The fusion of the faculties of medicine, odontology and health care into the Sahlgrenska Academy in July 2001
- In-depth co-operation with the rest of the University, Chalmers University of Technology and other universities
- Partnership with Sahlgrenska University Hospital, hospitals in the region and with the National Dental Service in Göteborg
- Extensive co-operation with external parties/companies

Internationalization at the Medical programme

- International dimension at all levels/areas
- 50 % of graduated involved in international exchange
- Focus on master thesis
- Focus on global health
- Responsible teacher for each country
- Recommendations on possible courses at different partner universities



Master thesis

- 10th term (out of 11)
- Individual scientific work
- 30 ECTS – 20 weeks full time studies
- 8-12 weeks abroad

- The course gives the student experiences of sciences and research.
- The student should acquire an increased knowledge and an enhanced understanding of a medicinal area and get training in how critically examine, integrate and present complex medical and scientific information.

The Project

Can be experimental, epidemiological, clinical or an analytical systematic review of the literature.
